AAPA and INACA co-organise Flight Safety Forum

Jakarta, Indonesia – Aviation safety professionals are meeting today in Jakarta, at the Indonesia Flight Safety Forum, co-organised by the Association of Asia Pacific Airlines (AAPA) and the Indonesian National Air Carriers Association (INACA). The event will address the challenges of meeting long term growth in travel demand, whilst focusing on the implementation of best practices in safety management.

Association of Asia Pacific Airlines (AAPA) Director General Mr. Andrew Herdman said, "Indonesia is one of the fastest growing aviation markets in the region, with 85 million passengers travelling by air last year. Aviation safety is a shared objective and we welcome the opportunity to partner with our friends in INACA to enhance aviation safety in Indonesia and the region." He added, "The forum will facilitate the effective exchange of safety information, sharing of industry best practices and serve as a platform for closer collaboration amongst Indonesian aviation safety stakeholders."
