**A RESOLUTION TO IMPLEMENT THE AAPA CABIN BAGGAGE POLICY IN  
NON-ASIA PACIFIC AIRPORTS**

The AAPA ASSEMBLY OF PRESIDENTS, in its 44<sup>th</sup> meeting duly assembled,

RECOGNISING THAT:

- I. the storage of heavyweight articles in the overhead bin has a direct safety risk to passengers and crew members;
- II. the limited stowage space in the aircraft cabin and excessive baggage carried into the aircraft compromise the comfort of all passengers;
- III. the extra time spent by airlines to intercept excessive, heavy, or bulky carry-on baggage can affect the operational integrity of a flight;
- IV. an AAPA cabin baggage policy was established and implemented through the cooperation of the airport authorities in members' home airports;
- V. passengers boarding a flight may originate from airports with different cabin baggage policies, resulting in misunderstanding and confusion;

BELIEVING THAT:

- VI. all passengers have a right to expect cabin safety, comfort, and operational integrity from airlines with whom they travel;
- VII. a consistent cabin baggage policy should be applied at all major airports to reduce misunderstanding and confusion among their passengers;

RESOLVES:

- VIII. TO SUPPORT the implementation of the AAPA Cabin Baggage Policy, as provided in the Attachment, at non-Asia Pacific airports;
- IX. TO SOLICIT the cooperation of airport authorities in non-Asia Pacific airports to implement the AAPA Cabin Baggage Policy.

CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE / LIMITATIONS FOR PASSENGERS TRAVELLING ON  
AAPA (ASSOCIATION OF ASIA PACIFIC AIRLINES) MEMBER AIRLINES' INTERNATIONAL  
FLIGHTS

No. of Pieces	1 pc
Dimension	subject to stowability, the total linear dimensions (length + width + height) of each baggage may not exceed 115 cm.
Weight	Up to 7 kg per pc

IN GENERAL, FIRST AND BUSINESS CLASS PASSENGERS MAY BE ALLOWED ONE MORE ITEM, SUBJECT TO SPECIFIC AIRLINE AIRCRAFT CONFIGURATION AND STOWAGE AVAILABILITY.
