Series of 2001**

**A RESOLUTION FOCUSING ON AVIATION SECURITY ENHANCEMENT**

The AAPA ASSEMBLY OF PRESIDENTS, in its 45<sup>th</sup> meeting duly assembled,

RECOGNISING THAT:

- I. recent terrorists acts using commercial passenger aircraft as weapons pose new security concerns to air travel;
- II. although air travel remains the safest mode of commercial transportation, there is a global requirement to urgently meet higher levels of aviation security;
- III. the AAPA is committed to take all possible steps to continuously improve aviation safety and security;

BELIEVING THAT:

- IV. the safety of employees and passengers is a top priority;
- V. in addition to the internal and individual efforts by each member to improve aviation security, there is an urgent need to expand and enhance cooperation concerning aviation security matters between member airlines and other global airlines and associations;
- VI. steps must be taken to address the security concerns and implement improved security measures while at the same time to minimize the impact of those measures on the traveling public and aircraft operations;

RESOLVES:

- VII. TO SUPPORT the ICAO in the development and adoption of new enhanced security standards;

- VIII. TO SUPPORT and participate in the Global Aviation Security Action Group (GASAG) in developing new aviation security measures;
- IX. TO ASSIST, in whatever way possible, airport operators, security agencies, aircraft manufacturers and/or regulators to adopt solutions to improve aviation security;
- X. TO STRONGLY PARTICIPATE in industry initiatives aimed at improving aviation security, through the Security Committee members or the AAPA Secretariat; and
- XI. TO INSTRUCT the Security Committee to review the security initiatives of their airlines and together with other related AAPA working groups, to focus on security enhancement measures amongst member airlines.
