**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ICAO LINE OPERATIONS
SAFETY AUDIT (LOSA) PROGRAMME**

The AAPA ASSEMBLY OF PRESIDENTS, in its 45th meeting duly assembled,

RECOGNISING THAT:

- I. air travel remains the safest mode of commercial transportation, but there is room for improvement;
- II. accidents/incidents caused by human factors are a major threat to the safety of airlines;
- III. LOSA is an effective tool, endorsed by ICAO, and gaining wide acceptance by the global aviation community;
- IV. the AAPA is committed towards safety enhancement measures;

BELIEVING THAT:

- V. LOSA has the potential to reduce human factors related accidents/incidents when used in a non-punitive manner and in conjunction with an effective Flight Operational Quality Assurance (FOQA) programme;

RESOLVES:

- VI. TO SUPPORT the ICAO efforts in implementing LOSA;
- VII. TO PARTICIPATE, through the AAPA Secretariat and the FOSWG in LOSA related programmes;

- VIII. TO COMMUNICATE, through the AAPA Secretariat and the FOSWG, developments in the LOSA programme; and
- IX. TO MONITOR the effectiveness LOSA through feedback from AAPA members.
