

Emerging market economies relatively resilient



Dollar surge diminishing spending power










Systemwide Passenger Operations, Year-to-Sep 22 as a % of Year-to-Sep 19



Cargo tracking the global economy






Demand under pressure, driven by declining export orders

Sustainability – Time to Deliver

- 41st ICAO Assembly
 - ✓ Long Term Aspirational Goal (LTAG) of Net-Zero Carbon Emissions by 2050
 - ✓ LTAG pathways: production and deployment of sustainable aviation fuel (SAF)
 - ✓ Plus CORSIA for CNG2020
- Government support & incentives
- Fuel supplier investment, knowhow for energy transition
- Taxes only increase cost of travel, not supply & take-up






Aviation safety record still intact

Aviation Safety: Next Generation Challenges

Lack of Resources

- Women
- Pilots, cabin crew, technicians, ground staff, security personnel
- Attract, motivate, innovate
- Spare parts slowed by supply chain woes

<u>5G</u>

- FAA mandate to replace/upgrade radio altimeters by July 2023
- Rollout of new C-band spectrum without "catastrophic disruptions"
- For US telecommunications operators, not aviation safety
- Supply chain and cost issues on retrofit parts
- Extra-territorial application





Aviation Security: Contingency Planning



- Cyber threats:
 - Airlines, airports and aviation ecosystem being targeted
- Cyber resilience of safety critical systems
- Aviation cybersecurity capacity building and implementation
- Increase awareness on addressing cybersecurity in civil aviation



Facilitation – Lessons Learned (COVID-19)



- Uncoordinated pandemic rule-making in long supply
- Flexibility & coordination in short supply
- Lack of notice to industry
- Myriad apps with NO interoperability

<u>Coordination & Interoperability</u>: Common data, encoding, understanding & trust framework



Technology for seamless, contactless travel



- Contactless digital & biometric tools to global standards
- E-passport, VDS-NC and facial/tactile technology
- Off-airport pre-clearance for convenience
- Multilateral dialogue

Mobile one-stop easy solutions for quick & secure travel experience and confidence

Slots Management: Infrastructure Issue





- Uneven pace of border reopening
- Slot management is not a response for capacity limitations
- Infrastructure planning crucial to meet future growth
- Safety and Fairness



Taxes & Charges: Airlines are not cash cows

- Rising cost must come with benefits
- Charges based on real costs & outcomes
- Not to recoup losses
- Transparent, non-discriminatory & frequently reviewed





Headwinds – Oil, Interest Rates, Carbon Price






Crack spreads at historical highs

Air fares tracking demand




